The Alabama team consisted of High School seniors and some of their mother's and teachers from their school. The Montana team consisted of four young guys that no job was too big for them!

They joined our Amazon team in Leticia and off we went to different villages to build eight tables for a children's feeding station in Peru, painted walls in classrooms in Brazil, and held the First Woman's Conference in Colombia!

Nothing was going to stop her from blessing the children with her artistic gift! The teachers were so grateful that the walls were decorated for the next day when the children were returned to class!

Everything that could go wrong on the day of the woman's conference did! It was getting just ridiculous! We stopped and prayed and we all decided it was going to happen no matter what the weather, food, transportation or how we were feeling. We survived and at the end of the day we knew God was the one in control and everyone was happy and blessed! When a door shuts, God opens a window and some times we have to jump out the window to make something happen!





The women had no idea what was going to happen during the conference, but they came ready to receive something new from God. That is exactly what they received! We served breakfast at 8 AM: Colombian coffee and Danish then Mrs. Patti taught the first class as I translated from the book; Love and Respect by Emerson Eggerichs.

(I recommend everyone young and old, single or married to read this book it is simply amazing!)

OK OK back to the news...

After a short break my Mom taught on the same subject and then we served lunch, rice with chicken, salad and fruit for dessert. It was yummy! We then proceeded to have open questions and answers! WOW that was interesting. These women really had excellent questions and were taking in the information like sponges! Here are a few of the questions: 1. Can I leave the father of my children that does not want to marry me? 2. What if he does not want to go to Church with me and rather I not attend? 3. What do I do now that my husband, the Pastor of the Church left me for another woman in the congregation? These are just a few of the issues..... We answered every question and had the opportunity to **pray for every single woman** that attended. (67) We also gave them a gift bag that included the book from the same author, but focused on one of the chapters of Communication. They all asked us to return and have the Second Woman's Conference ASAP!



God is truly wonderful and we are very excited to see how He is working through the feeding stations, the water purification systems and conferences! **I will be leaving again in fourteen days to the Amazon** with a team from CFNI to continue the work there.

On that same note since there is so much to be done **Justin and I would like to move there for three to six months and be hands on several projects for a longer period of time.**
