Dear Friends,

Tania and I greatly appreciated your love, prayers and your interest in our missionary work. This last year here in the Amazon basin has been a time of adjusting to a new life style, not only as a young couple but as a new missionary family with a destiny to fulfil.



We are totally aware of the unique opportunity we have here to reach out to the un-evangelized tribes in the Amazon jungle and the strategic position we have been placed in by God.

As time goes on with missionary work and starting a family, the financial needs have been increasing. Missions work is a two part ministry that works as one. In order to stay in the mission field doing what God has called us to do, we have to raise our own financial support, right now we need to have a financial miracle happen.

During the first three months of this year I, Joshua have been doing pioneering mission work with Amazon Xpeditions through discipline, teaching and evangelizing indigenous youth. In January we put together a Tikuna Youth Conference in the village of Filadelfia. With the participation of several visitors from USA we were able to minister a message of hope to 170_ Young people coming from many small villages along the river. Many of them having an opportunity to receive Jesus in their hearts for the first time.

At the same time we built a Water Purification System besides the Filadelfia church for the youth conference and for the community to enjoy pure water from now on. Each system costs \$4,500 totally installed and provides pure water for an entire village. This one produces 6,000 liters a day.



In March Tania and I have been with the Amazon Xpeditions visiting teams from Montana and Alabama, in several villages in Brazil and Peru, evangelizing and feeding children, participating on an evangelistic "Art's Festival" for young Tikuna people in Bella Vista Peru and Tania participated in a "Women in Leadership Conference" in Leticia Colombia.

On our down time here, I've learned Spanish and Portuguese, I've become fluent on both languages and I have served as interpreter in several Medical clinics, at the same time I have invested time to get familiarized with other local tribal languages in order to find opportunities to communicate the Gospel.

The missions agency I work with, Amazon Xpeditions, has established an strategy to evangelize entire Indian villages helping them to solve their most urgent and critical needs, like pure drinking water, medical care and children feeding projects.

Through these humanitarian aid projects we can make relationships, gain access, bless the people and evangelize them more effectively.



Tania and I are currently living with the Tikuna tribe, working with native believers. Here, along with the other missionaries, we are serving the indigenous communities with the feeding programs, children and youth evangelization, discipleship and basic education.



It is such a blessing to be apart of Gods work. In the Bible it says **“when you've done it to the least of my brethren you've done it unto me”** And we are doing it! Some of the meals the children receive here will be their only meal for that day!

Our goal and purpose here is to fulfill Matthew 28 v 19-21, **“Go and make Disciples”**etc., and to see to it that we are bringing the gospel to the un reached tribes in the Amazon, we use the tools God has placed on our hands to make an eternal difference in the lives and destiny of the people on these tribes.

I believe you have been encouraged in your heart, receiving this mission report from us and we do appreciate the time you have taken to read it.

Now, the question is, do you want to make sure this will continue to happen? Do you want to be a part in having the people from these tribes saved by the knowledge of Jesus Christ? I believe your answer is Yes, and we hope you will help us make a difference, through your prayers and your monthly financial support, to have this mission fulfilled.

Right now we have urgent financial needs as a family. We are believing God for a real miracle. Will you believe with us for an increase on our monthly support? Would you be part of that miracle?
